H1N1 VACCINE FOLLOW-UP CLINIC

MRCA will hold the follow-up H1N1 Clinic sponsored by Parkside Pediatrics next **Wednesday, February 3rd beginning at 3:30 p.m.** All children 10 years of age and under who had the H1N1 vaccine in December are required to receive the “booster” vaccine. **As well, Parkside Pediatrics is pleased to offer the initial vaccine to anyone who would like to get the shot.** Remember, parents are **required** to be with their children when the vaccine is administered and must complete the consent form before the vaccine will be given. Cost of the initial and/or booster shot is \$19.00. **Parkside Pediatrics will be donating \$1 from each vaccine back to MRCA; in turn, MRCA will donate these proceeds to the medical relief efforts in Haiti.**

New Consent forms will be available on Wednesday, February 3rd. Please have the consent form completed and your **cash** (change will be available) ready when you receive your shot. **Please let the office know by Monday, February 1st if you will be coming to this follow-up clinic.** If you have any questions, please contact the school office, x302.
