## SERVE-A-THON - "DOING THE HARD THINGS"

Please be sure all monies collected are placed in the Collection Envelope provided in each student's Serve-A-Thon packet. The Contribution Records (blue sheets) and check or cash donations should be placed in the Collection Envelope and turned into each student's classroom or homebase teacher. All checks are to be made payable to MRCA with 'SERVE-A-Thon' noted on the memo line along with the student's name. All SERVE-A-Thon donations are tax deductible. A thank you letter will be sent to each donor confirming their contribution to MRCA.

Remember, the money raised during the SERVE-A-Thon will be used for our campus-wide "Technology Makeover." It is our desire to replace all the faculty laptop and desktop computers which will greatly benefit our classrooms across the board through up-to-date access to next generation technology. Funds will be used in the Computer Lab to update the present projector with a "Smart Board" and replace the outdated monitors with flat screens giving students more workspace. As well, a portion of the funds raised will help with the annual 8<sup>th</sup> grade Guatemala Mission Trip project.
