3:00-6:00 pm



We are so excited for our 2020-2021 school year and honored to have your children in ACE. Below is our daily schedule.

3:00-4:00 pm

- An ACE worker will escort K3 and K4 students to the preschool playground.
- K5-4th grade students will be dismissed to the tree on the grassy area, in the safety zone, outside the Learning Commons exit. An ACE worker will check attendance and dismiss students to playground.
- 5th-8th grade students will go directly to the playground at dismissal and check in with an ACE worker.
- We will remain outside, weather permitting. Younger students will be on the preschool playground while the older children will be located on the main playground. Middle schoolers are allowed to be on the "big playground" however they typically stay outside the fence in the safety area.

**If you are picking up at this time please park near the old gym/middle school building and come to the playground to sign them out.*

4:00-4:30 pm

- We will provide a snack in the lunchroom. The snack menu will be posted, in the ACE room, every month for your convenience. Your child may bring a snack from home if they would like.

**If you are picking up at this time please come to the lunchroom door and a staff member will let you in.*

4:30-5:00 pm

- K3-1st grade will take turns using the restroom. Once everyone has gone a teacher will escort them back outside to the playground.
- 2nd-8th grade will stay in the lunchroom for 30 minutes to complete homework.

**If you are picking up at this time please come to the lunchroom door and a staff member will let you in.*

5:00-6:00 pm

- We will be back outside. If the weather is too severe, we will remain indoors. K3-K5 students will be in room 205 located on the preschool hallway. Students 1st-8th grade will be in the ACE room, located beside the lunchroom. We have several toys for your child to play with, board games, art supplies, crafts, etc. We will watch a movie on Fridays 4:00-5:30 pm.

**If you are picking up at this time please come to 6 glass doors, ring the doorbell and a staff member will let you in.*
