

Extended Day Program

(12:00 – 3:00 pm)

Welcome to Extended Day!

We are so excited for the upcoming school year and are honored to have your children in our Extended Day program. Our goal is to create a fun, caring, and structured environment where your child can have an enjoyable experience after their regular school day.

Below is some important information about our program to help you prepare for the year ahead.

Here is a brief overview of a typical day:

- Put away bags and lunchboxes/belongings
- Wash hands, have lunch and clean up
- Playtime outside or inside (weather dependent)
- Quiet time – while naptime is optional, we do have students stay on their mats for 45 minutes. We have found that the majority of students end up falling asleep. Students that do not sleep are able to do a quiet activity during this rest time.

Items your child will need for Extended Day:

- Water bottle – must be labeled with your child's name
- Oversized t-shirt for crafting
- Lunch – you may provide a meal for your child from home or have your child order lunch in their regular classroom in the morning upon arrival at school. Extended Day is not able to order lunch for any child in our program. If your child forgets to order in the morning, we can provide a corn dog, side (i.e. chips), and drink, which will be charged to your child's lunch account.
- Small blanket
- Buddy/stuffed animal

All Extended Day students who stay until 3:00 pm will be picked up in the elementary car line, unless they have a middle school-aged sibling - in which case, they will be in the middle school car line.

Please do not send toys from home. We have plenty of fun and engaging toys and activities at school, and we want to avoid the risk of personal items being lost or damaged.
