



## Life Threatening Allergy Parent Agreement Page

Mitchell Road Christian Academy is **NOT** Allergen Free or Peanut Free. Therefore, Mitchell Road Christian Academy is **NOT** guaranteeing or warranting that a student will **NOT** be exposed to peanut or other food allergens in the school environment, on a field trip, or on school retreats.

**As the parent and/or guardian I understand and agree to the following by July 31<sup>st</sup> of each school year:**

- Provide a Mitchell Road Christian Academy Allergy Action Plan (AAP) completed by a medical professional regarding the specific allergen that affects my child.
  - This documentation will include:
    - A **current** picture of my child.
- Provide at least two EpiPens in their original labeled boxed container for my child.
- MRCA will provide Benadryl (Diphenhydramine) to be used as needed at school. If a different antihistamine is prescribed, the parent/legal guardian will be responsible for providing it.
- If my child is interested in playing sports, an additional EpiPen and Benadryl must be provided prior to tryouts for their coach to carry unless my child has written permission from their physician to self-administer and have medications with them at all times.

Preschool and Elementary students will have an EpiPen located in the classroom “Emergency Red Bag” and lunchroom. Middle school students will have an EpiPen located in the middle school office and lunchroom.

If deemed necessary by medical professionals and so indicated on the Mitchell Road Christian Academy Allergy Action Plan (AAP), your child may also keep an EpiPen with him in addition to the locations listed above.
