General	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Attire should be neat, modest, and in good condition. •Hats are not permitted inside the building. 	
Uniform Shirts and Polos	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Uniform shirts must be purchased from one of MRCA's approved vendors. •Uniform shirts must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, light blue, white. •Long-sleeved shirts may be worn underneath short-sleeved uniform shirts. •Students must have a navy uniform polo shirt for field trips and group class photos. 	
Shorts, Skirts, and Skorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Items may be purchased from any vendor, including but not limited to our approved vendors. •Items must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, black, or khaki. •Items can be twill, denim, corduroy, or dry-fit/performance tech fabric. •Athletic mesh material shorts, skorts, or skirts are not permitted for everyday wear. •Items must be at least fingertip length. 	
Dresses and Jumpers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Jumpers and dresses may be purchased from any vendor. •Items must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, black, or khaki. •Items can be twill, denim, corduroy, or dry-fit/performance tech fabric. •These items must be at least fingertip length. 	
Leggings	<p><u>Girls:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Leggings of any color, pattern, or design may be worn underneath skirts, shorts, dresses, or jumpers. •Leggings may not be worn on their own in the place of shorts or pants. <p><u>Boys:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Boys may choose to wear any color, pattern, or design of athletic leggings underneath their uniform and/or PE shorts. 	
Pants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Pants may be purchased from any vendor including, but not limited to, our three approved vendors. •Pants must be in one of the following colors: navy, gray, black, or khaki. •Pants can be twill, denim, corduroy, or dry-fit/performance tech fabric. •Navy sweatpants, fleece, and athletic mesh material may only be worn on P.E. days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Sweatpants, fleece, and athletic mesh materials of any color are not approved for everyday uniform wear.
P.E Uniforms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Students must wear regular MRCA-approved uniform shirts to P.E. class. •On P.E. days, students may choose to wear regular approved uniform attire or fingertip-length athletic shorts, sweatpants, fleece, or windpants that can be purchased from any vendor, all of which must be <u>navy</u>. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Middle school students are required to wear a specific P.E. uniform during P.E. class only. •The P.E. uniform consists of a navy P.E. shirt that must be purchased through Lands' End, and fingertip-length <u>gray</u> mesh athletic shorts which can be purchased from any vendor.
Spirit Wear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Spirit wear will be offered for purchase at specific times of the school year. •On Fridays only, students may wear spirit wear shirts, MRCA middle school sports shirts, or other shirts that have been supplied/bought through MRCA such as Band, Student Council, etc. MR Sports Club jerseys may not be worn on Fridays. •On special dedicated days set by teachers and/or coaches, students may also wear shirts from student clubs/sports groups. Those days will be communicated to students as they happen throughout the year. 	
Outerwear	<p><u>Inside the building:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Students may wear any jacket, sweatshirt, or sweater that is purchased from one of our approved vendors in approved school colors and embroidered (by one of our uniform vendors) with the MRCA logo. •Students may wear any sweatshirt or outerwear that is sold and/or provided by MRCA. This includes spirit wear sweatshirts, and sweatshirts from MRCA sports or other MRCA extra-curricular clubs. <p><u>Outside the building:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Outerwear worn only outside the building (during recess, break, or car line) may be from any store or provider, including but not limited to MRCA or an MRCA approved vendor.
